Other Fees	Cornerstone Classical Christian Academy does <u>not</u> charge additional fees for textbooks, activities, etc.

Tuition Assistance	Cornerstone Classical Christian Academy offers need-based financial assistance to families on a first-come, first-served basis. Levels of tuition assistance offered will depend on a number of factors including total (gross) family income, number of family members, number of children enrolled at Cornerstone Classical Christian Academy, and any additional extenuating financial circumstances. To apply for tuition assistance, simply complete a Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA) application (available from the school or at www.ffna1.com) and submit it according to its enclosed instructions. <u>It is expected that families will pursue every other available means of financial assistance (family, other scholarship funds, etc.) prior to applying for aid directly from Cornerstone Classical Christian Academy.</u>
Enrollment Deposit	Families whose children have been accepted to Cornerstone Classical Christian Academy will receive an enrollment contract that must be completed and returned to the school. This enrollment contract must be accompanied by at least one-tenth (1/10) of the family's total tuition obligation for that academic year.
Payment Options	<p>Option 1: If a family's total tuition obligation for that academic year is not paid with the return of the enrollment contract, then one (1) lump sum payment of any remaining tuition balance on or before September 1st.</p> <p>Option 2: If a family's total tuition obligation for that academic year is not paid with the return of the enrollment contract, then nine (9) monthly payments are due on or before the first day of each month beginning with September 1st, with the final payment due on or before May 1st. Each of these nine payments must be at least one-ninth of the family's total remaining tuition obligation for that academic year.</p>
Uniforms	Each family is responsible for paying for their child's student uniforms. Certain uniform items must be purchased from designated suppliers.
Waiting List	In the event of a full class, a child may be placed on our waiting list after all other admission requirements have been fulfilled and application fees paid. You will be notified in writing of your numbered position on this list. You may withdraw from the waiting list at any time. Returning students will be given first priority in filling available spots. Second priority will be given to siblings of returning students. The remaining openings will be filled by new applicants (who meet all admissions requirements) on a first-come, first-served basis.
