EXPECTATIONS

- Expectations
 - Practice is mandatory
 - If you must miss for some reason, let a coach know before hand.
 - During the season, if you play football for CCA, you only play for CCA. No cross playing between CCA and JDL is allowed this year. This is a safety concern to protect your athletes from overuse and injury, which we saw a lot of last year. Football games should be limited to one game per week.
 - Summer Conditioning is a must, whether you workout with us at CCA or on your own, you
 must show up in shape at fall camp in August. A CCA Football summer workout packet will
 be issued before the end of spring practice.
