## Parents'/Guardian Code of Conduct

The mission of Cornerstone Classical Academy Athletics is to develop confidence, self-esteem and sportsmanship through the performance of team sports, while promoting physical and moral character development to all participants. To ensure the appropriate atmosphere for these activities, the school has adopted a

zero-tolerance policy in the enforcement of this Parents' Code of Conduct.

- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in CCA Athletics by following this Parents' Code of Conduct.
- I (and my guests) will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other CCA Athletics event.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parents such as booing and taunting, refusing to shake hands or using profane language or gestures.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will pay the athletic/transportation fee for each sport, failure to pay athletic fee will result in student being ineligible for future CCA athletics.
- I will return the issued uniform and equipment to the school at the conclusion of the season.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake of losing a competition.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will ensure that my child and myself will refrain from the use of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol at all CCA Athletics events.
- I will treat Cornerstone and opposing team facilities with respect.
- I will remember that the game is for youth not adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will help my child enjoy the CCA Athletics experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, volunteering or providing transportation.
- I will volunteer at two (2) home contests or pay a \$150 volunteer opt-out fee per sport.
- I do understand that I will abide by the above Code of Conduct, if I do not live up to the Parents' Code of Conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include but is not limited to the following: verbal warning by official, coach or CCA Athletics director; ejection from gym or field; parental game suspension, game forfeit; or season suspension with no refund of fees.
